On the ground floor, garage with electric gate, fitted cupboards and a laundry area. Bay windows allow transparency on the entrance hall. Large bedroom with shower room and separate toilet, opening onto a covered terrace.

The 1st floor offers a spacious bright room with designer kitchen, dining area, large living room opening onto a terrace to the south, partly covered, very quiet. The open staircase plays with the heights of the levels to create a contemporary architecture.

On the 2nd floor, 1 large room composed of an office, 1 shower room and a mezzanine bedroom. Note the beautiful oak staircase designed by the interior designer.

1 master bedroom with integrated bathroom (Starck bath) opening onto a terrace with garden view.
